- Both inside and outside booths will be numbered and reserved in order they are received. If you were a vendor at the 2022 show, you will be placed in the same booth unless you chose to setup in a different location (and it is available)
- Friday setup available for all vendors with teardown at the conclusion of the show on Sunday at 5pm
- We will take vendors until May 5th .Outside booths are readily available with limited inside spots.
- No guns, no weapons, no ammunition, no knives. Collectible pocket knives will be allowed with prior approval. Contact the fair office for any eligibility questions.
- NO SMOKING in any building on the fairgrounds
- No refund for individual cancellation without committee approval
- All food vendors will be required to provide current certificate of insurance and fulfill all requirements of the Knox County Health Dept.
- All trash should be removed from individual booth spaces during teardown
